"Fred Chance. Bought a **Pony Express from Oak Creek in Sanger**, Texas. We had an **F2 tornado come through** and doing so, on the property. We live on 12 acres up here. It took ah, we have a metal barn that it completely lifted the metal barn off the ground. Threw it at about, I don't know, three or four acres away from the house. Completely destroyed my son's roof and fences. I have never seen a barbed wire fence get pushed down by wind. But it did. And the only thing it did do to our house was the wind removed one end of our awning on the porch cover on the porch. As far as our house goes, that's the only thing it did. **We didn't lose a shingle**. We didn't lose a. We did lose the front storm door. Cause the wind threw a board into the door. And it shattered the glass. But other than that, we had. We didn't... **Our house did not sustain any damage**. It took a carport next to our house, raised it up about eight inches off the ground. I have an eight foot by 20 foot tool shed out back of the house. Raised it up and kinda twisted it. But our house was fine. Didn't damage our house at all. You know I've heard I guess my whole life, I'm 68 years old. **I've always heard don't live in a mobile home. Well, I'm glad we were living in this one**."
